Provide Burn Clinic
Information to all patients in

Instruct the following to
schedule an appointment
with the Burn Clinic:

Any worsening burn injury


If you are prescribing a topical medication

Any burn injury that will require treatment for greater than 5 days

Any burn injury you feel requires follow-up

Guidelines for Referral to the Emergency Center

- * Any burns >1% TBSA
- Any burns larger than the palmar surface of the patient's hand (*reference Palmar Method below)
- Burns to any high-risk location such as face, hands, feet, genitalia, perineum, or major joints
 - Electrical Injury
 - Chemical Burn
 - Suspected Inhalation Injury
- Patients with chronic conditions affecting wound healing
 - Any Suspected Non-Accidental Injury
 - Old Burn Injuries >24hrs



PALMAR METHOD (Patient's palm) *This document has been created for the local providers of UMCP, as well as other local non-UMC associated clinics, with a purpose to assist in the awareness of when to refer the burn injured patient. This guideline is not to serve as a hospital transfer guideline for any entity outside of the designated population.
