Have you been able to document some of your clinical skills on Galen?	
What skills are you the most comfortable with?	
Communication Skills/Handling Conflict	
How comfortable are you with communicating with your charge nurse/physicians?	
Any uncomfortable situations? How did you handle it?	
What is your biggest challenge? What did you learn?	
Have you experienced reality shock? What would you do different?	
Review Nursing Organizational Chart, Strategic Goals, and unit goals	
Review Social Media (NA Policy 168) & (HR 36.5)	
Patient Satisfaction-What's in it for me?	
What feedback have you received?	
Have you had your 90-day evaluation? Performance Manager / Setting Goals?	
Professional Advancement Opportunities	
Identify short term and long-term goals? How can I help you achieve your goals?	
Transfer eligibility (12-15 months based on contract period). (Policy HR 32)	
Educational Reimbursement: (Policy NA 134.1)	
Have you considered going back to school?	
80% reimbursement per semester, up to \$8,000 per year, 1 year to UMC post-graduation
